



Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010 CONTRACT (DRAFT)

THIS CONTRACT entered into on date of signature below by and between _____, the newly crowned Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010 and an official representative of the Miss Rodeo Virginia Program (Program).

WHEREAS, THE NEWLY CROWNED Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010 is desirous of attending the Miss Rodeo America Pageant as a representative of the State of Virginia, and WHEREAS, the Miss Rodeo Virginia Program is desirous of sponsoring the said Miss Rodeo Virginia, between them this Contract is read, understood and agreed.

ELIGIBILITY

Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010 shall:

- 1) Not be less than 19 or more than 26 years by December 31, 2010 the same being evidenced with a copy of her birth certificate.
- 2) Never have been married, had a marriage annulled, pregnant, or given birth to a child nor shall you during the year of your reign.
- 3) Sign Waiver of Liability.
- 4) Be a legal resident of the State of Virginia, as evidenced by a validly issued drivers license and /or voters registration card issued by the State.
- 5) Never have been charged and/or determined to have committed any crime of moral turpitude nor has had a title removed for any reason.
- 6) Abide by the Miss Rodeo Virginia Guidelines and Procedures.
- 7) Have not heretofore authorized any person, firm or corporation to use name, photograph, picture, present or future title in connection with any endorsement of advertisement or any commercial product or service; and am not under any contract or other obligation to any person, firm or corporation or have any legal obligation which would prevent participation in an appearance at the Miss Rodeo Virginia Pageant or the Miss Rodeo America Pageant, or which would prevent or hinder compliance with the duties, terms, conditions and obligations hereafter specified.

DUTIES

As Miss Rodeo Virginia, you agree to abide by the Miss Rodeo Virginia Guidelines and Procedures. You agree to prepare for and compete in the 2010 Miss Rodeo America Pageant in Las Vegas, Nevada. If you fail to attend the Miss Rodeo America Pageant and such failure is caused by your own volition, you will be obligated to reimburse the MRV Program and sponsors for all monies and items won and the 1st Runner-Up then may assume the title and finish out the term.

If, as Miss Rodeo Virginia, you fail or refuse to perform the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the MRV Board may at its discretion require your immediate resignation, with or without cause, and shall immediately forfeit and return to the MRV Program all awards, prizes which you have received or to which you would otherwise be entitled. In the event of your resignation or removal, the MRV Program may select, in order from the pageant results, a successor. As successor to the title, she will be entitled to receive such prizes, and awards as may be determined by the MRV Program.

As Miss Rodeo Virginia, you agree to be solely responsible for your personal property and well-being; and shall neither ask for, except, nor receive compensation or reimbursement from the MRV Program for any loss sustained by you as a result of participating as Miss Rodeo Virginia. You shall save and hold harmless the MRV Program, Board and committees from any and all liability for your actions and conduct during your term as Miss Rodeo Virginia and for the MRV Program, Board and committees' actions or conduct with respect to any rights herein granted.

As Miss Rodeo Virginia, you are in an official representative of the Professional Rodeo Cowboy Program and should constantly be aware of the value of public relations between the general public and those actively involved in Pro-Rodeo and your responsibility to uphold your title.

The MRV National Director will be the person who will work directly with Miss Rodeo Virginia to coordinate schedules and appearances. Should the National Director feel certain events would be good exposure for Miss Rodeo Virginia she can schedule these events, and Miss Rodeo Virginia shall make every effort to attend these functions and events. The MRV Program is in no way responsible for Miss Rodeo Virginia traveling expenses to and from said appearances.

Procurement of any funds, fund raising and/or donations under the title of Miss Rodeo Virginia shall be approved and distributed by the National Director. Miss Rodeo Virginia shall, either personally provide or solicit sponsorships for her expenses in order to fulfill her duties as Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010. She will receive 100% of funds raised to benefit Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010. All funds raised for benefit of Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010 must be deposited into the Program MRV 2010 account for reimbursement of expenses incurred during her official duties. Miss Rodeo Virginia will fully disclose to the MRV National Director any financial or product donations made to her in support or sponsorship of her duties as Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010. This information is to include amount or type of assistance, and all contact information.

Miss Rodeo Virginia will turn over any and all monetary sponsorships of Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010 made payable to "Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010" to the National Director for deposit into the Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010 account. In addition, she agrees to submit reimbursement forms including original receipts for approved expenses incurred while carrying out her duties as Miss Rodeo Virginia 2010. Priority for expense reimbursement will be given to clothing and accessories for use at the Miss Rodeo America 2010 Pageant as well as for fuel, food and lodging while on an official appearance. Any other expenses will be reimbursed at the discretion of Miss Rodeo Virginia National Director with the titleholder's best interests in mind. All reimbursement forms and receipts must be turned into the National Director before December 31, 2010. Any funds remaining in the account that are not scheduled for reimbursement by January 1, 2011 will be used at the discretion of Miss Rodeo Virginia Program.

All funds raised to benefit the Miss Rodeo Virginia Program will be kept separate and disbursed for expenses of the Program.

When fundraising to benefit both the Program and Miss Rodeo Virginia occurs, the division of the proceeds will be established before the event.

CONDUCT AND DISQUALIFICATIONS

- 1) It is the duty of Miss Rodeo Virginia to portray the highest moral standards, show the true ideals of young womanhood and set an example above reproach.
- 2) Miss Rodeo Virginia must conduct herself as an example to the public, which includes no smoking, drinking, chewing, foul language or inappropriate social behavior during her reign.
- 3) Miss Rodeo Virginia should never be seen at a bar, lounge, or social event where alcohol is served unless under the direct supervision of the Miss Rodeo Virginia Program representative, whether it be as MRV or personally.
- 4) Miss Rodeo Virginia must not marry, or become pregnant during her reign.
- 5) Miss Rodeo Virginia shall not maintain any form of cohabitation with another person during her reign.

Should any of these rules not be adhered to, Miss Rodeo Virginia is subject to losing her crown and the title would then be given to the 1st Runner-Up.

The MRV National Director is responsible for the proper, personal and professional conduct of Miss Rodeo Virginia and will insure that the rules are strictly adhered to. Should it become necessary for the crown of Miss Rodeo Virginia to be removed, the National Director will bring the grievances to the Miss Rodeo Virginia Program Board where action will be decided.
